Introduction – Annual Results for FY2023



SEQI: A platform with scale, proven through cycles

- 8+ year track record of meeting dividend targets, weathering an extraordinary range of market conditions
- Market-leading listed credit fund with scale: NAV of c. £1.6bn
- Low costs at 96bp per annum OCR
- Liquidity with c. 3 million average shares traded daily

Portfolio performance remains resilient in face of external capital market challenges

- NAV per share reduced to 93.26p over the year, mainly due to exceptional increase in interest rates and credit spreads, resulting in a substantial (unrealised) downward mark-to-market
 - Substantial upside via "pull-to-par" as loans approach maturity (average life 3.5 years)
 - o Adjusting for this "unrealised mark" would give a NAV total return of more than 6% for the year
- Share price return of -16.1% reflecting technical equity market challenges
 - o Buyback Programme implemented in July 2022
- Portfolio cash flows strong in FY2023 based on resilient portfolio, floating rate resets and attractive yields on new credits
 - Yield-to-maturity of 11.9% as at 31 March 2023 (2022: 8.4%)
 - SEQI's Board increased the annual dividend target by 10% to 6.875p per share from the second half of FY2023
 - FY2023 cash dividend cover: 1.21x (2022: 1.06x)







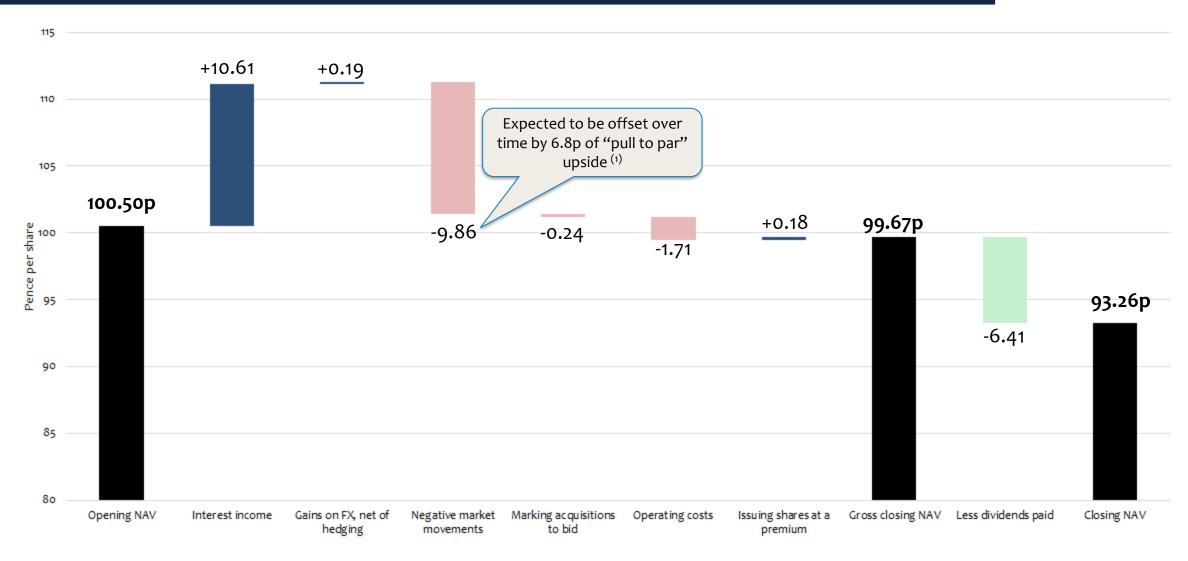

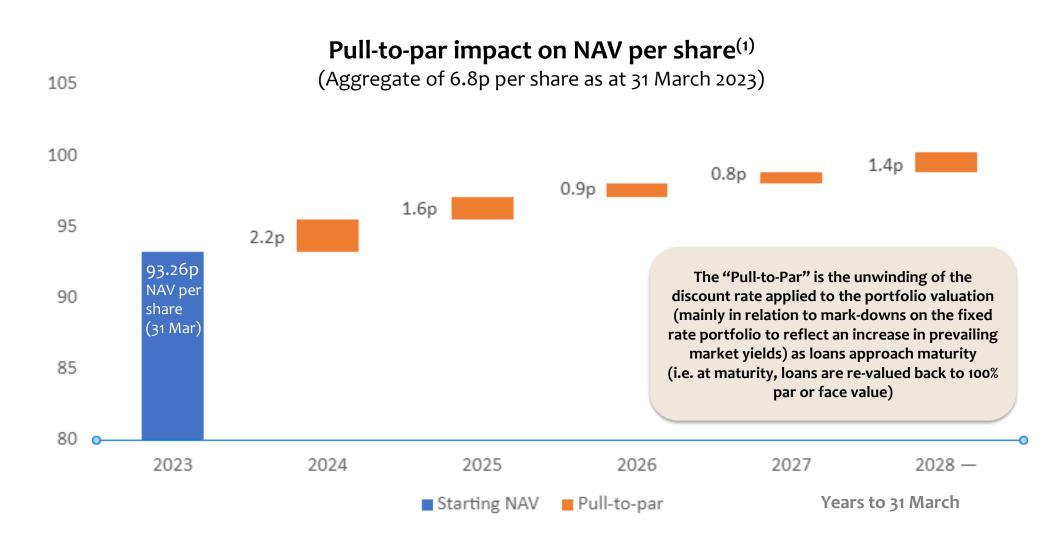
NAV per share bridge for FY2023





SEQI – Pull-to-Par on the portfolio





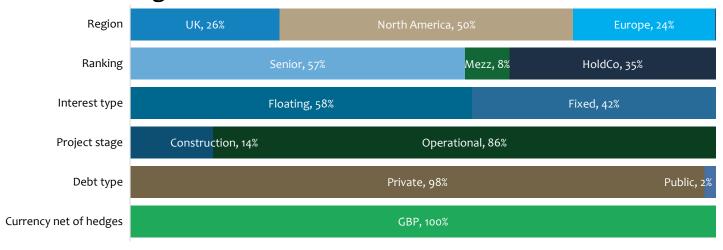

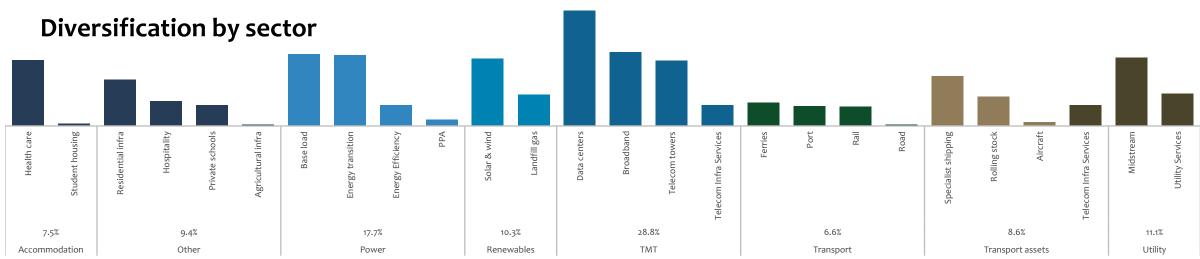

Portfolio categorisations



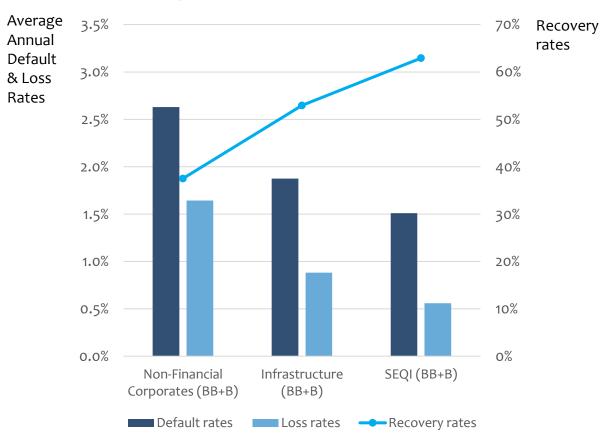


SEQI's portfolio credit performance



- Managing some difficult credits is an inevitable and important – part of successful high yield infrastructure portfolio management
- Broad range of exogenous factors impact on infrastructure credits over time
- SEQI diversification ensures risks are limited
- SEQI continues to outperform market benchmarks on aggregate default and loss rates over time, with higher recovery rates
- Two of the portfolio loans remain in workout:
 - 4000 Connecticut Avenue
 - Secured by high quality real estate asset
 - Reletting process underway
 - Bulb / Simple Energy
 - Restructured with SEQI now taking equity in branded technology platform

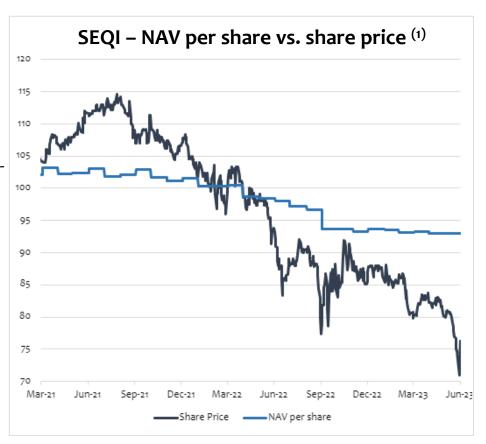


Background

- SEQI has not been immune to the broader sell-off in listed alternatives
- Amongst other facts, this largely results from substantial "portfolio repositioning" by some UK investors, generally a reaction to exceptional changes in "risk-free" rates in 2022-23
- SEQI's portfolio is currently 74% outside the UK (including half in the US where inflation is showing signs of peaking) => intrinsically less exposed to UK capital markets "anomalies"
- Interest income (10.6p per share) has increased, allowing for an increased and wellcovered dividend
- Losses from SEQI's diversified portfolio remain low, well below market levels

Actions underway

- Implemented buyback in July 2022. Over 60 million shares bought back since then
- Board and Investment Adviser alignment via holding and purchasing shares
- Redeployed capital highly selectively
- SEQI continues its accurate and timely reporting: our fresh monthly NAV per share is objectively benchmarked, externally assessed with no time delay or mismatch
- Investor engagement via 1-on-1s, group calls, Capital Markets Day; refreshed and expanded website at www.seqi.fund
